

Checkout Minimums for Ahart Aircraft

Listed below are the minimum requirements to fly as Pilot-in-Command in the type of aircraft listed. Additional experience may be necessary depending on the outcome of the checkout flight performed by Ahart's Flight Instructor. Currency requirements include Private Pilot or better SEL time in past 60 days and rental time with Ahart in past 4 months.

Please note: you must fill out an aircraft performance review sheet prior to your checkout.

- Student Pilot or better Private Pilot or better
- CFI sign off or checkout with a CFI

Piper Arrow II & IV 2003 Cessna 172SP

- Private Pilot or Better Private Pilot or Better
- Complex Endorsement Checkout with CFI
- 75 Hours Total Time (separate checkout not req'd)
- 05 Hours Retractable Gear Time if C172N, P or R model
- 02 Hours Make and Model checkout already completed.)
- Checkout with a CFI

Cessna 182T Piper Seminole

- Private Pilot or Better Private Pilot or Better
- High Performance Endorsement Multi Engine Rating
- 100 Hours Total Time 250 Hours Total Time
- 05 Hours High Performance or Arrow 25 Hours Multi-Engine
- 02 Hours C182 05 Hours Make and Model
- Checkout with CFI Checkout with CFMEI
- 01 Hour Currency every 45 days or recheck with an MEI
